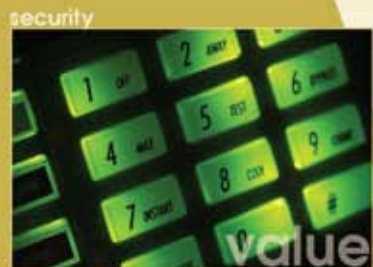
Security Systems
